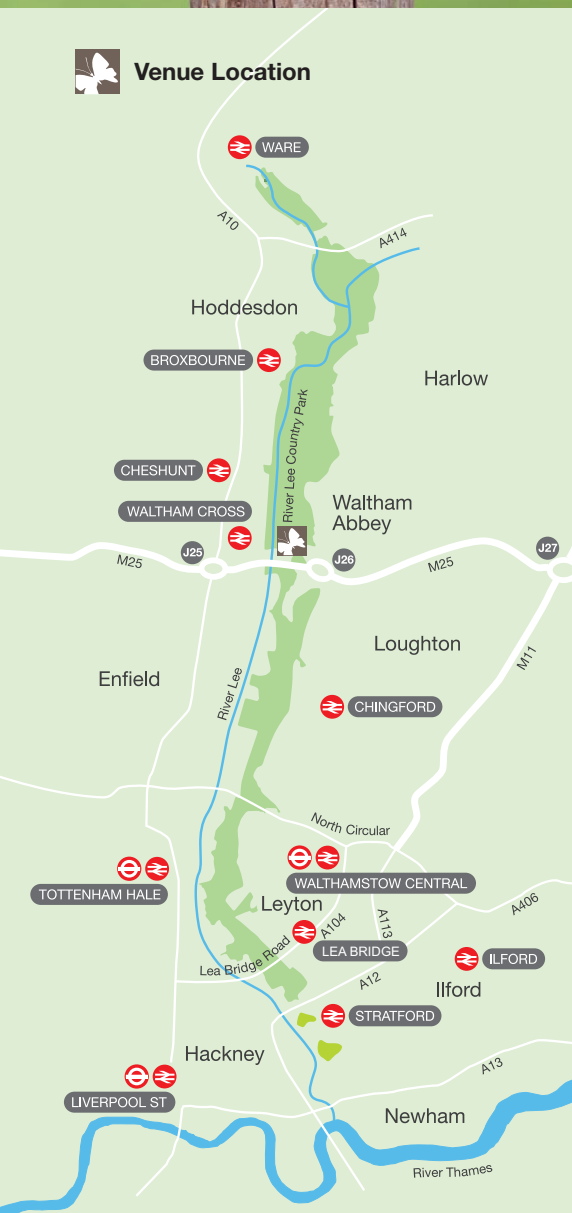




Venue Location



A key area for duck and wading birds

This site consists of open water and a shallow scrape with grazing water meadows. It's important for a range of species but particularly duck and wading birds. This site is also a key part of River Lee Country Park for both Otter and Water Vole. A beautiful grazing meadow with the hum of insects on a warm summers day is a popular venue with visiting wildlife enthusiasts.

Adoption of this site will support us in the management and improvement of the habitats in this area.

Facilities

- Area where marquees can be erected
- Car parking can be arranged – five minute walk
- Transport links: main line train station 15 minute walk and easy access from junction 26 on M25
