FEES & CHARGES REVIEW 2020/21

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report sets out the proposed charges for 2020/21 for the six Leisure Services Contract Sports Venues that are returning for a short transition period within the direct control of the Authority. These are:

- Lee Valley Athletics Centre;
- Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre;
- Lee Valley Ice Centre;
- Lee Valley Riding Centre;
- Lee Valley VeloPark; and
- Lee Valley White Water Centre.

Following the decision to temporarily bring the Sports Venues within the direct management of the Authority from 1 April 2020 (Paper A/4277/20) the fees and charges have been reviewed directly with the venue managers for the interim arrangement. The tight timetable since that decision has meant wider comparison with other attractions and similar venues has not been possible for the report. A further review may take place depending on the successful transition to the new contract operator and if this is the situation which arose then this will be brought for information purposes to Members prior to the contract start.

RECOMMENDATION

Members Approve:

(1) the Authority's proposed 2020/21 fees and charges as summarised from paragraph 4 and set out in detail in Appendix A to this report,

BACKGROUND

Fees and Charges from the six sports venues are estimated to generate £6.9m in 2020/21. Due to the transfer back from Lee Valley Leisure Trust Ltd (the Trust) to the Authority there will be a change in VAT liability, with most fees no longer being VAT exempt. The fees and charges have not increased to take account of this due to the short term transition expected as the incoming Contractor will be a charitable organisation and will be able to apply the VAT exemption on sporting activities in future. This will mean income will be lower than previous years.

We are currently exploring the possibility and impact on the Authority's VAT position of applying the VAT exemption on sporting activities.

The six sport venues are included in the Leisure Services Contract (LSC) until 31 March 2020 and the current contractor had not prepared detailed pricing for the forthcoming financial year. The Authority does not have access to the detailed financial/usage records of the current year's performance, but has maintained communication links with venue managers and has worked with these colleagues to prepare the information.

Therefore, in setting fees and charges for these venues ahead of 2020/21, it is proposed that due to the limited financial information currently available, the process of transferring venues back (during what will already be a busy period of transfer of operational controls) that most prices will increase by inflation unless there are exceptions as set out in the paragraphs below.

- 3 The Authority reviews all its fees and charges annually and the impact of any proposals are fed into the annual budget. These have a direct impact on income and therefore the levy.
- 4 Appendix A to this report sets out proposed charges for the financial year 2020/21 for sites, facilities and heritage attractions operated by the Authority. In summary the estimated income is set out below.

- The Retail Price Index (RPI) for December stood at 2.2% and the Consumer Price Index (CPI) stood at 1.3% and this has broadly been used as the basis of price review with managers, also taking a view about local demand and price sensitivity.
- The overriding principles in setting charges are set out in the approved fees and charges policy and are:
 - i. venues should aim to break even (excluding overheads);
 - ii. sustainably improve market share/usage; and
 - iii. equality through concessionary pricing.

EXPLANATION OF CHARGES

7 Lee Valley Athletics Centre

The majority of the fees and charges for day to day activities are proposed to be frozen. The gym sales have been steady, but are at the upper end of local markets. There has been good growth in non-athletics events and these will be targeted and commercial rates applied.

8 Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre

Where the demand is currently still strong (peak time indoor courts) managers are recommending an increase in line with inflation but where demand has decreased or is static (the outdoor courts where there is significant supply and cheaper court hire in local parks) a proposed freeze to the charges for 2020/21 is recommended.

9 Lee Valley Ice Centre

Some changes are proposed to have a single charge for adults and juniors and offering a 'family' ticket which is any group of four people and also removing the peak and off-peak pricing for groups as the individual ticket pricing has not included this distinction for four years. This removes discrepancies with groups and encouraging larger groups which should also improve café sales.

10 Lee Valley Riding Centre

Where the demand is currently strong managers are recommending an increase in line with inflation. Private livery currently has vacancies and a new product for livery including mucking out will be offered. The remainder of prices for livery have been increased by less than inflation to retain customers.

11 Lee Valley VeloPark

The vast majority of the income is generated from the velodrome and there has been a decline in Taster/Try It and similar sessions so a price freeze, and in some cases a reduction, to attract more customers is proposed. The marketing of such courses has been unsuccessful during the last 18 months and sales of vouchers in key periods has dropped significantly. There is a national decline in velodrome use reported by other velodromes and targeted marketing is essential and will be done leading into the Olympics, with interest of course being driven by GB success.

12 Lee Valley White Water Centre

Some areas of income have stalled during the last 18 months (although this may be associated with unsuccessful marketing and targeted approach). As a result, and with the inclusion of additional products, many of the base prices will remain static. The use of the Legacy Loop now operates using two pumps rather than three which has allowed a decrease in price offered as the cost to run the pumps is significantly less and net profit increased. The prices for commercial charges are negotiable and show the minimum charge. Managers seek the best price possible to secure the bookings.

13 Car Parking

Car park charges for non-users and users staying over a reasonable period (this has not changed since 2016 and is 4 hours at Lee Valley VeloPark and Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre to reflect the activity duration) and will continue as currently reflecting local car parking charges in and around Lea Bridge Road and Stratford/Westfield for Lee Valley Ice Centre, Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre and Lee Valley VeloPark. Full details of car

parking is included at Appendix B to this report.

14 Implementation

The approved fees and charges will come into effect from 1 April 2020 when the Authority takes temporary control of the venues. The estimated impact of the approved fees and charges has been incorporated into the 2020/21 budget proposals for the LSC Sports Venues which will be presented to this Committee in March.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

15 There are no environmental implications arising directly from the recommendations in this report.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

16 Estimated income from the proposed fees and charges will be incorporated within the budget for 2020/21 and monitored through monthly management and quarterly monitoring reported to Members.

HUMAN RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

17 There are no human resource implications arising directly from the recommendations in this report.

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

18 There are no legal implications arising directly from the recommendations in this report.

RISK MANAGEMENT IMPLICATIONS

The Authority's net budget and therefore levy depends on income generated from fees and charges. Income can be adversely or favourably affected by weather, market demand factors and pricing in the wider economy as a whole. To mitigate this risk the Authority agreed that reserves are set aside at a prudent level (the current minimum reserve policy is £3-£4m and this will be reviewed as part of the 2021/22 budget process) and that business interruption insurance is in place.

EQUALITY IMPLICATIONS

20 The Authority's Fees and Charges Policy sets out criteria to ensure access to services are available to disadvantaged groups through a concessionary pricing structure that considers income and ability to pay.

Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre and Lee Valley VeloPark customers are entitled to up to four hours free car parking upon entering the car park and staying within Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre/Lee Valley VeloPark. This was implemented to retain the carparks for visitor use and discourage parking for other nearby activities/visits and encourage public transport (and cycling and walking).

If taking part in hockey or tennis or cycling activities at the venues, customers obtain this free parking by entering personal details and vehicle registration number into one of the terminals within the venue. If a customer wishes to stay longer than the four hours, then there are additional parking terms and charges applied. There is a price and time difference between the two venues due to the location to other Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park facilities such as the 'Tumbling Bay' playground and event spaces and also walking time to the Olympic Stadium. The pricing is set to encourage use of other car parks at Here East, Westfield Shopping and Stratford International rail station car parks.

Tariffs for non-venue users and for hockey/tennis users staying past four hours:

- Up to 1 hour £3
- Up to 2 hours £6
- Up to 3 hours £15
- Max stay 3 hours no return within 2 hours

Tariffs for non-cycling users and for cycling users staying past four hours:

- Up to 1 hour £4.
- Up to 2 hours £8
- Max stay 2 hours, no return within 2 hours

Car Parking charges and management was introduced at Lee Valley Ice Centre due to increased use when the Lea Bridge rail station was refurbished and to react to more car parking by the residents and visitors of the apartments adjacent to the venue. As the car park is used by visitors to Leyton Marsh and Walthamstow Marshes, the fees have been kept low for visits, with larger fees to discourage use as a commuter carpark and non-visitors.
